Statement of Boarding Conditions

- The parent(s) or guardian shall pay the school such Boarding Fees and Charges for the supply of goods and services to the student, as shall be determined by the School Board from time to time.
- Boarding fees shall be payable prior to the first day of term to which they relate. Other charges are payable on demand and may be subject to alteration from time to time without notice. The principal may refuse permission for a student to re-enter the college if any fees or charges for any preceding term have not been paid.
- The principal must be given one term's notice in writing prior to the withdrawal of a boarding student, or a term's fees will be charged.
- The college reserves the right to discipline, suspend or expel from residence at any time any student whose behaviour is considered by the principal to be unacceptable.
- The parent(s) or guardian will make good any damage to college property or equipment caused by their child.
- The parent(s) or guardian are held responsible for the punctual attendance of their child at the beginning of each term and for their punctual return after leave.
- 7 Students must wear the appropriate school uniform in good and clean condition and in such a way as to show pride in being identified with the college.
- **8** The college accepts no liability for personal property brought to the college.
- **9** The college reserves the right to inspect the rooms at any time that is considered reasonable.
- All students are bound by all rules and regulations as may from time to time be issued by the principal for the safe and proper conduct of the college.
- All students must take part in the ordinary college activities including the physical education and outdoor education programs. Exception is allowed by the principal only on medical advice.
